

Level 3 BTEC in Performing Arts (Dance)




How will I be taught?

You will learn, create, perform and critically analyse and evaluate Dance. You will develop sophisticated technical, performance and creative skills in a variety of styles including: Hip Hop, Contemporary, Commercial, Jazz, Afro and Musical Theatre.

The units covered require you to investigate the history and development of dance styles through time and how practitioners' contextual backgrounds have shaped and influenced professional works. You will develop your technique and performance through daily practical lessons that lead to a final performance piece for each unit and investigate the life of a dancer through research and your own experiences. You will then reflect upon your strengths, weaknesses and areas for development.

Units 3, 5, 4 and 6 require you to engage in professional practice during a creative process to create original dance work based on a variety of stimuli. This will develop your ability to work with a variety of dance genres, music and stimuli to create dance work for target
